Patient Assistance Tool (PAT)

A '**good medicine and good money**' approach to chronic disease management (CDM) in General Practice.

PAT is an easy step by step approach to CDM and health assessments. It contains a number of clinical decisional support pathways. For CDM, a full assessment is done via the General GPMP & TCA.

PAT also has 3 cycles of care: asthma, diabetes and COPD which can be completed later in the 12 month period if relevant. It is patient centred and empowering shifting workload from the Doctor or Nurse to the patient.

PAT automatically links to **Best Practice**. In the general GPMP, active problems from the BP health summary are automatically extracted to formulate an individualised approach. Once completed the GPMP output goes into the Care Plan Section of BP. The general GPMP automatically generates a TCA as well.

The one hour session will run a simulated patient through the programme and you will have chance to talk to GPs using PAT already.
