Checking your child's immunisation history record is accurate can help to make sure you continue to receive your Child Care Benefit (CCB) and Child Care Rebate (CCR) payment or Family Tax Benefit Part A supplement.



## Step 1 Sign In to myGov website www.my.gov.au

**Note:** If you do not have a myGov account you will need to create one, by visiting the myGov website and clicking

**Step 2** Click on the green "Services"

**Step 3** Locate "Medicare" listed below "Member services"

If Medicare is <a href="Linked">Linked</a> proceed by clicking on "Medicare"

If Medicare is Volinked proceed by clicking on (S) to link

**Note: To** link Medicare to myGov you will need your Medicare card details and details of your last appointment with a General Practitioner.



<u>Step 4</u> The Medicare website will prompt you to check your details, if correct then click PROCEED TO ONLINE ACCOUNT

If incorrect, make any necessary changes, then click

Apply Updates



<u>Step 5</u> Then click "<u>Immunisation history statement"</u> under Australian Childhood Immunisation Register, the immunisation history statement should now be displayed

**Note:** Parents can only view immunisation history statements for children under 14 years of age, children over 14 years of age are required login and view their own history statement
